EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMUNITY AWARENESS KIT



Every year over 5,000 Australian children are rescued after being left unattended in a car.

The temperature inside a parked car can be 20 – 30 degrees hotter than the outside, with most of the temperature rise occurring in the first five minutes. Children are particularly at risk because they can lose fluid quickly, become dehydrated and suffer from potentially life threatening heatstroke.

EARLY CHILDHOOD 'DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN IN CARS' AWARENESS KITS

As part of the 'Do Not Leave Children in Cars' campaign, Kidsafe Victoria has developed a community awareness kit for early childhood centres. The kit provides early childhood centres with tools to raise awareness about the dangers of leaving children unattended in cars.

A key feature of the kits are Kidsafe Victoria's 'Do Not Leave Children in Cars' carpark warning signs which are ideally suited for early childood centre car parks. The signs act as an important daily reminder to parents and carers visiting the centre, about the dangers of leaving children unattended in cars.

All kits also include the provision of:

- Articles for inclusion in your newsletters or bulletins
- A 'Do Not Leave Children In Cars' campaign banner to place on your website

HELP KIDSAFE VICTORIA PREVENT CHILDREN BEING LEFT UNATTENDED IN CARS

By purchasing and installing 'Do Not Leave Children in Cars' signage in your car parking areas, your early childhood centre is supporting Kidsafe Victoria to raise awareness of the dangers of leaving children unattended in cars.

Leaving a child unattended in a car is potentially life threatening and an offence in Victo ria under the 'Children, Youth and Families Act 2005' (section 494 - Offence to leave a child unattended). The penalties for leaving a child unattended in a car in Victoria include a fine (currently \$3,690), a maximum of 6 months in jail, or both.
