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Kidsafe Training

Child Car Restraint Education Workshop

This one day workshop will provide participants with the knowledge and skills to install and select suitable child car restraints from a specific range of restraints for transporting children in their care.

Who should attend?

Suitable for any education, health or community professionals required to transport children as part of their job role. It is designed to be hosted by employers who wish to ensure their staff have the required knowledge and skills to safely transport children in their care.

Course Aim

This unit aims to provide participants with the capacity to educate consumers on the importance of correct selection and use of child car restraints. Information is to be provided in the context of current legislation and regulation.

In addition to the unit of competency requirements, a practical skills session will be conducted to demonstrate learning and practise restraint installation techniques for safely transporting children.

Course Information

 CRFPIA301[#] Provide information and advice on correct child car restraint use

This unit forms part of the nationally recognised short course *52862WA Course in Type 1 Child Car Restraint Fitting.* It is delivered as a stand-alone unit for those wishing to inform the community about correct child restraint use but **does not** qualify the participant to provide Type 1 Child Car Restraint Fitting services <u>or</u> be recognised as a Type 1 Child Car Restraint Installer.

To be recognised as a Type 1 Child Car Restraint Installer you need to successfully complete all requirements of *52862WA Course in Type 1 Child Car Restraint Fitting* (see alternative flyer for further information).

Entry Requirements

This course requires the satisfactory completion of oral, practical demonstration and written tasks. There are no specific entry requirements for *CRFPIA301 Provide information and advice on correct child car restraint use*, however a general command of spoken and written English, as well as the ability to write a simple report is required.

On successful completion of this training, participants will receive a Statement of Attainment for unit of competency outlined above, and a certificate of participation in the "Child Car Restraint Education Workshop".

Cost

\$220pp (A minimum of 5 participants or equivalent course fees are payable by a hosting organisation - \$1,100).



Duration

One day - 9am to 4pm* (Start & Finish times may vary and can be adapted to fit in with the hosting organisation's needs).
