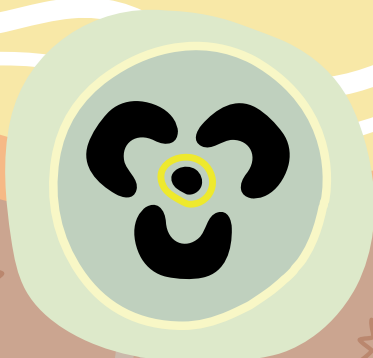


# CAR SAFETY



- ✓ Make sure all little ones are buckled up every time you get in the car
- ✓ Keep your child in the right seat for their size. The shoulder height marker will tell you when they are big enough to change seats
- ✓ Children must sit in the back – this is the safest spot for them
- ✓ The seat needs to be fitted in the car correctly – if you aren't sure, you can book in for a free check at [safeseatssafekids.com.au](http://safeseatssafekids.com.au)
- ✓ Every time you put your little one in their seat, check that:
  - The seatbelt is buckled up
  - The top tether strap is connected and not twisted or too loose
  - The harness straps aren't twisted or too loose

✓ Walk around the car and check before reversing
