

POISONING



- ✓ Lock away all poisons, including medicines and cleaning products, in a cupboard up high, at least 1.5 metres above the ground, where little ones can't see or reach
- ✓ Put bags up high where little ones can't get into them
- ✓ Check what plants you have at home and get rid of any dangerous ones
- ✓ Put locks on low cupboards and drawers to stop baby opening them
- ✓ If your little one has swallowed something that you think might be poisonous, ring the **Poisons Information Centre on 13 11 26** and follow their advice. In an emergency, call 000 for an ambulance.
- ✓ Keep poisons in their original containers and never in old drink bottles
