

Britax Scholarship Program Terms and Conditions

- Applicants must have a valid WWC and Police Check.
- Shortlisted applicants to attend a SSSK free child car restraint fitting and checking day (4 hours duration) as an observer before commencing the course, to determine if the course is right for them.
- Locations of two day course: South Eastern suburbs, Victoria.
- Location of ongoing training: Various locations to be determined by Kidsafe Vic.
- An up-front financial contribution of \$200 is required before commencing the course. This amount will be reimbursed on completion of course and 12 sessions.
- Scholarship recipients will be required to commit a total of 48 hours of their time across a mixture of locations (usually in 2-4 hour blocks).
- Session 1 & 2 – 52862WA course in Type 1 Child Restraint Fitting (2 full days).
- Session 3, 4 & 5 – observations will be the focus of these sessions with the ‘trainee’ assisting the professional child car restraint fitter and reporting on misuse and installation errors. If time permits, ‘trainee’ will (install/make adjustments) to the last installation of the day under the guidance of the professional child car restraint fitter. Education will also be a prime focus for the ‘trainee’ to observe.
- Session 6 & 7 – ‘trainee’ will fit/reinstall child car restraints (under the guidance of the professional child car restraint fitter) where an attendee has a double or triple appointment. Trainee will also be encouraged to provide education and guidance to attendees on basic use (adjustments). The professional child car restraint fitter will sign off on all installations and adjustments made by the trainee.
- Session 8, 9 & 10 – trainee will have the opportunity to fit multiple child car restraints under the guidance of the professional child car restraint fitter. Trainee will be encouraged to provide education and guidance to attendees on basic use (adjustments). The professional child car restraint fitter will sign off on all installations and adjustments.
- Session 11 & 12 – trainee will be encouraged to fit all child car restraints booked for the SSSK free child car restraint fitting and checking day. A professional child car restraint fitter will be in attendance to observe and assist at the events.
- The completion of this scholarship does not guarantee work as a child car restraint fitter, or subcontracting by Kidsafe Victoria.

- There are requirements and expenses (e.g. insurance) involved in establishing a child car restraint fitting business which are not covered by this scholarship.
